



## 3 November 2017 – incident notification

Dear local residents and businesses

We are writing to let you know that yesterday an incident was reported to the Environment Protection Authority advising that debris from cleaning a roof containing asbestos with a high pressure hose at the Goodlife Gym on the corner of Portrush and Payneham Roads had affected the area.

**An EPA investigation team immediately went to inspect the site and we can advise you that the following actions have been undertaken:**

- Containment – The site has been isolated
- McMahon’s have been contracted to clean up the site
- EPA investigators are onsite again today to inspect the clean up
- The EPA arranged the installation of air monitoring equipment yesterday
- The results from the air monitoring yesterday came back with no detection of airborne asbestos
- Today cleaning of the storm water system is underway, including the gutters, downpipes and roof
- The EPA is continuing to work with other agencies and a risk assessment is being undertaken
