EPA TREE PLANTING DAY



On Tuesday 19 September, staff from across the EPA took part in a tree planting day on a property near the town of Myponga as part of the Myponga Watercourse Restoration Project.

The project works with landholders to fence their watercourses to exclude unwelcome livestock, construct stock crossings and establish off-stream watering points.



With much laughter and enthusiasm, the group planted 800 River Red Gums, Swamp Gums, Silky Tea Trees, Swamp Wattles and Golden Sprays along a watercourse that had been fenced off.
