SCHEDULE 2 CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

If approval is granted to the class of containers referred to in Schedule 1, the following conditions will apply:

1 (Category B container)

The approval holder must ensure that the empty containers which belong to their respective class of containers hereby approved as Category B containers, are collected from collection depots approved under section 69 of the Act by the nominated super collection agency.

OR

(Category A container)

The approval holder must ensure that empty containers, which belong to their respective class of containers hereby approved as Category A Containers, after being returned to retailers for refund, are collected from retailers, by the approval holder (or an agent of the 'holder') and recycled in an appropriate manner. Disposal at landfill is not considered an appropriate method of disposal.

- (a) The approval holder must ensure that each container which belongs to their respective class of containers hereby approved as Category A or Category B Containers bears the refund marking approved by the Authority in respect of that class of containers.
 - (b) The refund marking that appears on each container that belongs to the class of containers that is hereby approved, must be a minimum 1.5 mm in height for the smallest letter in the statement, and a minimum 3 mm in height for the numeric in the statement.

And if a sticker is used to display the refund marking, the following condition will apply:

- 3** The holder of this approval must ensure that the sticker bearing the approved refund marking is not placed on any portion of the opening mechanism or in any other place that would require complete or partial removal of the sticker before the contents may be consumed.

Refund markings—a sample to accompany application

A sample of the label for the 'class of containers' identified in Schedule 1, displaying the refund markings, should accompany this application.

OR

A sticker may be used, ensuring refund markings comply with EPA requirements. A copy of the sticker must accompany this application form.

Exact wording of refund markings:

5c refund at collection depots when sold in SA
or
10c refund at points of sale when sold in SA

Note:

Size of refund markings:	– Numeric –	no smaller than 3 mm in height
	– Alphabet –	no smaller than 1.5 mm in height for the smallest letter

General information to note

The EPA may under section 69(6) of the Environment Protection Act, vary or revoke the approval, or any condition of approval, or impose a condition or further condition of approval. Consideration will also be given to the end use of the container and whether a recycling system exists for the container's material type/s.

I/We declare that I/we have authority to sign on behalf of the applicant and in doing so, hereby declare that to the best of my/our knowledge all details supplied in this application are correct.

I/We understand and accept the conditions that will be applied to any approval of a class of containers, granted in support of this application.
