## Air-monitoring school presentation

In early April, Jessica Gilding (Air Quality Education Coordinator) and Chris Powell (Air Quality Scientific Officer) visited students at Christies Beach High School and spoke about air pollution and air-monitoring systems.

Approximately fifty students from years 8-12 studying science and future sustainability attended the presentation and were given the opportunity to use a 'nasal ranger' monitoring device. Students also learnt about various types of air-monitoring systems and how they operate.
