Re: Brighton environmental assessment work update

Further to my letter of 1 May 2018, I am writing to provide an update on the environmental assessment work being undertaken in the Brighton assessment area.

Environmental consultant Fyfe Pty Ltd (Fyfe) has been engaged by the company that has liability for the site contamination. On 21 May 2018, Fyfe wrote to residents who live on Preston Ave and Keelara Street. The letter advised that Fyfe was planning to undertake the next stage of work on footpaths and roads near their homes. At this time, no work is proposed outside this boundary. However if this changes and future work is needed near your property, then Fyfe will advise residents accordingly.

The second stage of work was prompted by the identification of chlorinated hydrocarbons, primarily tetrachloroethene (PCE), in soil vapour. These chemicals are likely to be associated with underlying groundwater contamination and have the potential to enter indoor air spaces. Fyfe commenced the second stage of work on 25 May 2018. This work included the drilling and installation of a series of temporary and permanent soil vapour bores and groundwater monitoring wells. The results of this work are due to be reported to the EPA in early August 2018. A full copy of the report will be available on the EPA website.

Groundwater (bore water) in your area may be contaminated and should not be used for any purpose. Mains water supplied by SA Water is not affected by this issue. Home grown fruit and vegetables are safe to consume, provided they are not watered with bore water.

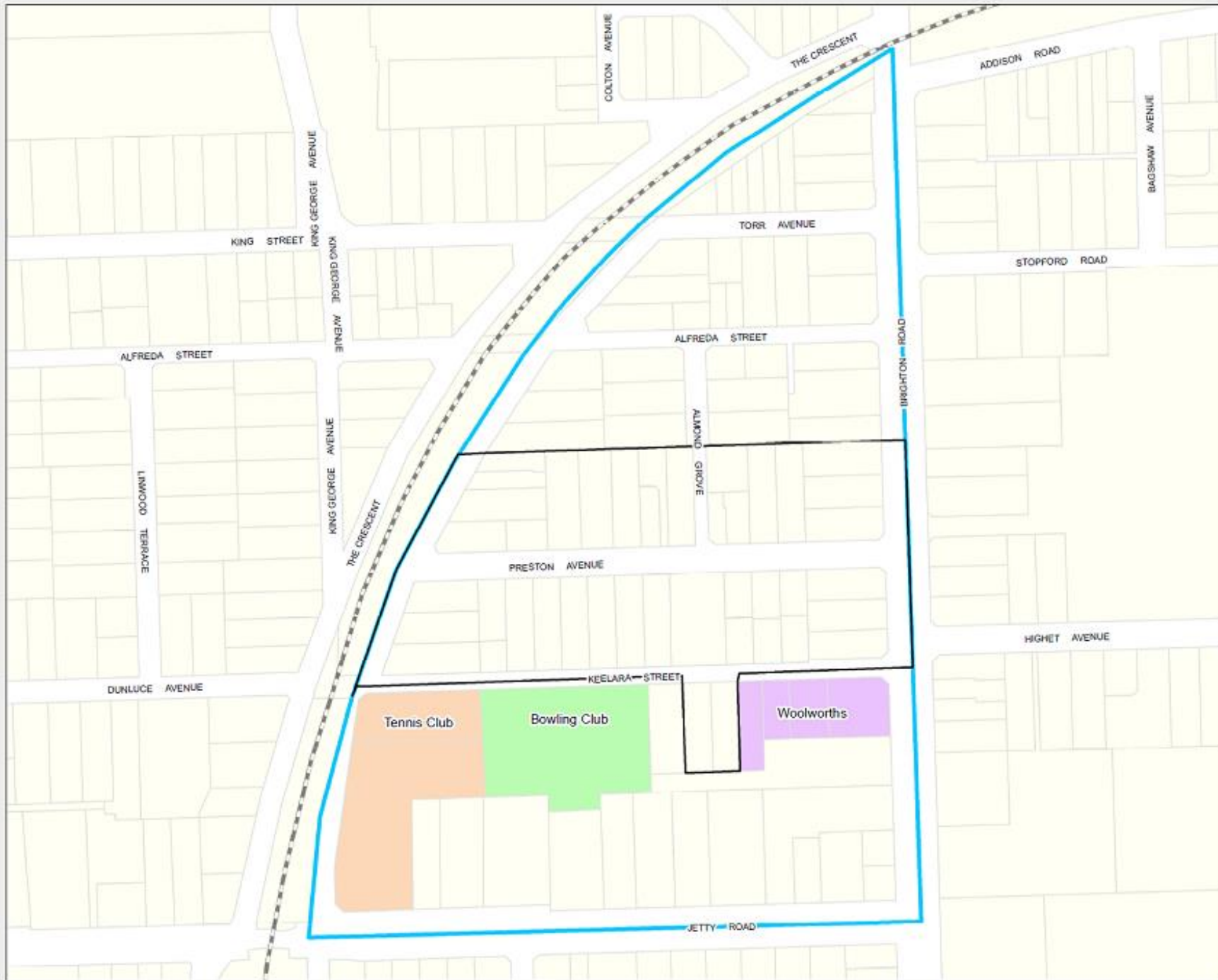
