The Environment Protection Authority has an obligation under the *Land and Business (Sale and Conveyancing) Act 1994* to inform you that it holds a copy of this cancelled licence, but this was not done.

Because the Authority holds a copy of this cancelled licence it will inform any prospective purchaser of this fact as required under Section 7 of the *Land and Business (Sale and Conveyancing) Act 1994*.
