

Chronology at Lightburn and Company Limited Factory Site

1946	Lightburn & Co. purchased 40 hectares of land in Camden (now known as Novar Gardens) for the purpose of whitegoods manufacture.
1952	Information held by the EPA, indicates that new Certificates of Titles with Lightburn & Co on them were created in May 1952.
After 1946	Light Manufacturing undertaken at the site - began operations to produce; <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mobile cement mixers• Washing Machines• Hydraulic Jacks• Fibreglass boats
1961 - 1964	Lightburn Zeta Sports Car manufactured (likely fibreglass?)
April 1986	A new licence to produce listed wastes was issued to the company in Mile End.
October 1986	Company ceased operation in Novar Gardens.
January 2006	Internal audit undertaken by the EPA identifies record of Waste Management Commission licence being issued for the site and residents notified.
